21. Which dish is made from 'feet and parcels'? Describe how it is prepared. *Pieds et paquets*. This dish consists of sheep's feet and stuffed parcels made from the lining of a sheep's stomach. The filling of the 'parcels' is a mixture of belly pork, garlic and parsley. All the ingredients are cooked together in a pan with wine, herbs and tomatoes.
